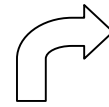

ADM – 801 Nile Kinnick Drive South, Adel.

Take Hwy 30 east to Ogden turn right on Hwy 169 south for approximately 30 miles to Adel. Continue through town to the south edge. The high school is off to the left. Parking for events in the high school is just north of the building. The football field and track is on the east side of the high school.

Travel time 1 hour 20 minutes.

Algona – 600 South Hale, Algona.

Coming into Algona from the south on Hwy 169 once in Algona, turn east on Chubb Street (car wash corner).

Travel time 2 hours.

Ames – 1921 Ames High Drive, Ames.

From Hwy 30, take the Duff Avenue exit. Go left (north) on Duff until 20th Street. Then go left (east) on 20th. You will eventually see the school. The pool is the dome shape on the south end of the building.

Travel time is 1 hour 15 minutes.

Ankeny Centennial – 2220 NW State Street

Take Hwy 30 east to Ames to I-35. Go South on I-35 to exit 94. Take Exit 94, turn right and go 3 miles west to NW State St. Turn left onto NW State St, school is on the right in 3/4 mile.

Travel time is 1 hour 36 minutes

Atlantic – 1201 E. 14th Street, Atlantic.

Take Hwy 71 south to Atlantic turn left at the first stop light and go south about 1/2 mile turn right on 14th St. and follow 14th St. For football keep going on 14th St. to Olive St. and turn right (north) go 1/2 block and the field is on your left. The baseball and softball complex is in the same area as the football field, on the west side of the Middle School. Park in Middle School parking lot. Nishna Hills golf course is at the corner of Hwy 71 and 14th St.

Travel time is 1 hour.

Underwood – 629 North St..

Take Hwy 71 south to I-80 west. To west for 42.84 miles to exit 17 County hwy G-30 exit). Turn right onto Magnolia Rd (county Hwy 3-30) for .47 miles. Take the first right onto Railroad Hwy 191 for .11 miles then turn left onto North St, school will be on the left.

Travel time 1 hour 36 minutes

Webster City – 1001 Lynx Avenue, Webster City.

Take Hwy 71 north to Auburn. Go east on Hwy 175 to Lohrville. Turn left and go north on N65 to Hwy 20. Turn right (east) on Hwy 20 and continue to Webster City. Take the Webster City exit and turn left into town. Go to the first stop light and turn left on Ohio Street, go as far as you can to the “T” intersection, then take a right on Beach St. and a left on Bank St. The football field is west of the high school.

Travel time 1 hour 20 minutes.

Nest Central Valley (Stuart) – 320 NE 3rd St., Stuart.

Take Hwy 30 east to Scranton. Turn right (south) on Hwy 25 to Bayard. Turn left (east) on 25 then south on 25 through Guthrie Center towards the interstate. Before the interstate take F65 east through Menlo to Stuart. In the middle of town turn right on P28 and go south for 2 blocks to S 3rd St and the soccer field will be ahead.

Travel time 1 hour 10 minutes.

Winterset – 624 Husky Dr., Winterset.

Travel east on Hwy 30 to Ogden. Turn right (south) on Hwy 169 all the way to Winterset. Hwy 169 becomes John Wayne Drive. Take John Wayne Drive through town to Summit St. and turn right (west). Take another left on 7th Ave to Husky Drive. (Golf) Take Hwy 19 south to Winterset. Take a left (east) turn onto Hwy 92. Continue east on Hwy 92 and turn left (north) on 10th Street to Lakeview Country Club.

Soccer is played at Earlham. *535 N Chestnut St.*

Take hwy 30 east to Scranton. Turn right on N33 and go to Bayard. Turn left on Hwy 141 and go 3 miles to IA-25. Turn right on IA-25 and go to I-80. Turn left onto I-80 toward Des Moines. Take I-80 to exit 104 and take P57 south to Earlham. Turn right onto I Ave which becomes Chestnut Ave. Soccer field will be on the left.

Travel time 2 hours.

Audubon – 800 3rd Street, Audubon.

Follow Hwy 71 south all the way through Audubon. The school sits at the south edge of town, to the east of the statue of Albert the Bull.

Travel time is 30 minutes.

Ballard –701 Ballard Drive

Take Hwy 30 east through Ames. Turn right onto Hwy 69 and go 8 miles south to Huxley. At the intersection of Main St. and Hwy 69 (a flashing yellow caution light) turn south onto Main Street. The school will be two blocks south. Golf events are held at Ballard Golf and Country Club, which is one mile north of Huxley on Hwy 69 on the east side of the road. Baseball games are played at Nite Hawk Field in Slater at Earl Grimm Park.

Travel time is 1 hour 20 minutes.

BCIG (Battle Creek- Ida Grove)–900 John Montgomery Dr.

Take Hwy 71 north from Carroll through Lake View. Continue west on Hwy 175 through Odebolt and Arthur. At Ida Grove turn left at the Country Club, go a block and turn left at the “Y” intersection then a right up the hill to the school. Softball - Take Hwy 71 north from Carroll to Lake View and continue west on ST/IA/75 to Battle Creek. Take the first right on N. Chestnut Street. Go about four blocks and you will see the entrance to the fields on the right. The softball field is located northeast of town.

Travel time is 1 hour.

Bishop Heelan Memorial Field – 100W 17th St., Sioux City, IA

From I-29 Take exit 3149 (Hamilton Blvd). (Football) Proceed north on Hamilton Blvd to 17th St. Memorial Field is located just off Hamilton Blvd on the east side at 17th St.

From Hwy 20 take Hwy 20 by-pass to 1-29 North. Proceed on North 1-29 and Take exit 149 (Hamilton Blvd). Proceed north on Hamilton to 17th St. Memorial Field is located just off Hamilton Blvd. on the east side at 17th St.

Boone – 500 7th St., Boone.

Take Hwy 30 east to Boone. At the four way intersection, turn north onto Story St. Proceed north into the downtown area. Turn left (west) on 7th Street. The high school is 5 blocks ahead on the left. For Football, Track, Soccer - From the 4-way stop on Hwy 30 on the south side of Boone. Turn North onto Story St. Turn left (west) onto Mamie Eisenhower Ave. Turn right (south) onto Division St. Goeppinger Field/Track is on your right. Baseball-Boone Memorial Park – East on Hwy 30 to 4 way stop at Boone. Turn left and go north on Story Street thru Boone to 19th St. Turn left and go 2 blocks west on 19th st. Turn right on Boone St., Memorial park is on your left. Softball – Boone Creasman Field – East on Hwy 30 to the top of the hill west of Boone. Turn left on Montana Rd and go north to the T intersection with W. 3rd St. (Circle Way) turn right on W 3rd st and travel through Boone to Division St. (Just before you get to Shell./Casey's/Football field) turn right on Division st and go 2 blocks south and turn left on College St., Creasman Field is on the right.

Travel time is 1 hour.

Boundurant-Farrar – 1000 Grant Street

For: Volleyball, Basketball, Wrestling Take Hwy 30 east to Ames, turn right and go south on I-35 to Exit 92, (1st St.) on the east edge of Ankeny. Take the 1st st, exit and go east 6-7 miles. Turn right onto NE 72nd St. and go south 1 mile. The Boundurant-Farrar High School will be on your left. Parking is on the south side of the high school. The Athletic doors are located at the SE corner of the building.

For: Soccer, Track, Baseball, Softball 300 Garfield St. SW From I-35 Take the Oralabor Exit, head east (this will turn into NE 78th Ave). At the four way stop, take a left onto Grant St. N. The high school will be on the right. If you reach a second four-way stop (NE 94th Ave), you have gone too far. Outdoor activities are located west of the school building.

Travel time 1 hour 45 minutes.

South Central Calhoun – 709 W. Main St., Lake City.

Take Hwy 71 north to Auburn. Turn right (east) on Hwy 175. Drive by the hospital and continue into Lake City a few more blocks. The school is on the right. Volleyball is played at Lake City. Basketball is played at Rockwell City. From Lake City go 4 miles east on IA-175 and 9 miles north on Hwy 4 to the SW corner of town.

Travel time 30 min to Lake City and 45 min to Rockwell City.

Spencer – (Football) From South or East, hwy 71 or 18, turn onto Grand Ave., cross the Little Sioux River, Turn right at East 2nd St. and follow it all the way out, the high school and field house are on the left or north side of the street. (Swim) Take Hwy 71 north to Spencer. It will curve around to the right and you will see HyVee and K-Mart. That should bring you to the intersection of Hwy 18 and 71. Turn left (north) on Grand Ave. and follow this through downtown until 11th St. Turn left (west) and you will run into the YMCA. (Golf) At the intersection of Hwy 18 & 71 turn left (north) on Grand Ave, and go clear through town to 18th Street. Turn left (west) on 18th St. until you reach Country Club Drive. The club house and golf course are visible from there.

Travel time 1 hour 30 minutes.

Storm Lake – 621 Tornado Drive, Storm Lake.

Take Hwy 71 north to Storm Lake. Swim meets are held at the BVU Pool. Turn left at the corner by the lighthouse. Go west until you come upon Buena Vista University. The pool is to the west of the football field in the lower level of Siebens Fieldhouse. Track and soccer are held at the high school, track just north of the high school, which is just off to the north side of Hwy 71, (also E. Milwaukee Ave) back in the middle of town (Football) turn left onto IA-7 W, then turn right onto Flindt Dr, turn right onto Oneida St, then turn right onto Tornado Dr.

Tri Center - 33980 310 Street, Neola.

Take Hwy 71 south to I-80. Take I-80 west to where I-80 and I-680 meet. Continue west on 680 for 1/2 mile. Exit right on to Hwy 191 and drive north 1/2 mile. The school is on the left.

Travel time 1 hour 30 minutes.

Jaydel – 5601 NE 7th Street, Des Moines.

Take I-80 east to 2nd Ave. exit and turn left (north) to NE 54th St. Turn right (east) on NE 54th. Continue to NE 7th and take a left (north) to the high school. *Travel time 1 hour 40 minutes.*

Sergeant Bluff-Luton – 708 Warrior Rd

Take Hwy 30 west to Denison, turn right onto Hwy 59/141 and go north 2 ½ miles, turn left on Hwy 141, follow 141 to I-29, Merge onto I-29 north for 13.44 miles, take exit 141, turn right onto 1st st, then right onto Port Neal Road, then right on Warrior Road
Travel time 1 hours 53 min

Sioux City East – 5011 Mayhew Ave, Sioux City.

Take Hwy 71 north through Auburn and Lake View to Early. North of Early turn left on Hwy 20. Follow Hwy 20 west to Sioux City. On the east edge of Sioux City, exit left onto Hwy 75/20 (I-29). Turn right at the Lakeport St. exit and north a few blocks to Mayhew Ave. The school will be on the left. Enter the west doors of the school. Parking lots on the west and south side of the building. Softball is played by the high school also. *Travel time 2 hours 15 min.*

Sioux City North (Metro)

at North High School, 4200 Cheyenne Blvd, Sioux City.

Swim at North High School. Take Hwy 71 north to Early, turn left (west) on Hwy 20. In Sioux City, Hwy 20 turns into Gordon Blvd on the south of the city. Stay on Gordon Drive heading west under the Memorial Bridge; Gordon Drive becomes I-29. Heading into South Dakota, exit right on Hamilton Blvd. Take Hamilton Blvd, north to Outer Drive. Take a right to Cheyenne Blvd. Turn left (north) on Cheyenne. The school sits on the east side. *Travel time 2 hours 30 minutes.*

Buena Vista University – 610 W. Fourth St., Storm Lake, IA 50588

Take Hwy 71 north to Storm Lake. Turn left at the corner by the lighthouse. Go west along the lake until you come upon Buena Vista University. The track is located around the football field on campus. *Travel time 1 hour.*

Carlisle – 430 School Street, Carlisle.

Take Hwy 30 east to Ogden, turn right and go south on Hwy 169 to Hwy 141 and go east to I 35/80. Continue south on I 35 to Hwy 5 exit. Take Hwy 5 – Carlisle exit and go around the south side of Des Moines to the Carlisle exit. Take Hwy 5 east into Carlisle. At the 2nd stop light (south 5th) turn left. The school is on the left. *Travel time is 2 hours.*

Cedar Falls – UNI Dome – From Carroll go north to Hwy 20. Take Hwy 20 east to Cedar Falls. Exit onto Hudson Road and go north to the dome. *Travel time 2 hours 45 minutes.*

Cherokee – 900 West Bluff, Cherokee.

Take Hwy 30 west to Denison to Hwy 59. Go north on Hwy 59 all the way to Cherokee. Continue through Cherokee to the 5th stop light, turn left, west on Bluff St., (Fareway) then right on Gillette Drive and follow up and around to the high school. Track meets are held by the high school. *Travel time 1 hour 30 minutes.*

Council Bluffs Thomas Jefferson – 2501 Broadway, CB.

Take Hwy 71 south to I-80. Take I-80 west for 52 miles to US-6 (exit 8), merge onto US-6 west and go 5.4 miles – school is on the left. *Travel time 1 hour 51 minutes.*

Creston -

Football- coming in from the west, you will go past the golf course and SWCC on the North. There will be a stop light. Then there will be an four way stop (True Value on North) Keep going east on Townline until you see the high school on the north. Turn in and follow the drive around to the back of the school. It is right there.....across from the bus barn.

Dallas Center-Grimes – 3353 240th Street, Grimes.

Take Hwy 30 east to Ogden; turn right on to Hwy 169, continue south to Hwy 44. Turn left and go east on Hwy 44 through Dallas Center for another 8 miles. DCG High School is in the country, one mile west of Grimes.

Travel time 1 hour 25 minutes.

HS Volleyball/HS Basketball/HS Wrestling-Contested at the High School. Located one mile west of Grimes on Hwy 44. Unloading in the front of the school on the south side. Enter through the south main doors. Buses should park at the south end of the main lot.

Denison-Schleswig – 819 N. 16th St., Denison.

Take Hwy 30 west into Denison. Turn right at 16th Street (Casey's) and go north to the high school and Athletic complexes. Golf is at the Denison Country Club. At the east edge of Denison turn left and go south on Donna Reed Drive. The course will be on the right.

Travel time is 35 minutes.

Drake Stadium – Des Moines.

Off of I-80 take Merle Hay Road south to University Ave. Turn left on University Ave. to the Drake campus. Drake Stadium is a few blocks north of University on Forrest. There is a large parking lot SE of the stadium and Knapp Center.

Travel time 1 hour 45 minutes.

Des Moines Hoover – 4800 Aurora Ave., Des Moines.

Off of Interstate 80, turn onto Merle Hay Road and go south to Aurora Avenue. Turn left onto Aurora and go east 6-8 blocks. Park west of the school.

Travel time 1 hour 45 minutes.

Des Moines Lincoln – 2600 SW 9th, Des Moines.

Off Hwy 141, take I 35 south. Take the Des Moines Airport exit (Hwy 5) east till SW 9th, then north on SW 9th about 25 blocks.

Travel time 2 hours.

East Sac County – 100 W. 2nd St., Wall Lake

Softball is played at Wall Lake – Take Hwy 71 north to Auburn, turn left and go west a few miles. At the curve, go left (west) on D59 through Carnavon to M64. Turn right on D59/M64 and go north to Wall Lake. Turn left on W. 1st street and drive west to Complex Drive. Turn right onto Complex Drive to the softball complex.

Ogden – 732 West Division Street, Ogden.

Take Hwy 30 east to Ogden. Exit onto Hwy 169; go north into Ogden to Division St. Go left (west) on Division St. about 6 blocks. The school is on the left. *Travel time is 45 minutes.*

Perry – 1200 18th Street, Perry.

Take Hwy 30 to Scranton. Go south on Hwy 25 to Bayard. Turn left on Hwy 141 through the stoplights to Perry and continue east to 10th Street (hospital). *Travel time 1 hour.*

1. Highway 141 to Perry.
2. Exit Highway 141 at first Perry exit: Willis Avenue.
3. Follow Willis Avenue west to 18th Street.
4. Turn north on 18th Street.
5. Perry Community High School is located at the corner of 18th Street and McKinley Avenue.
6. Locker rooms are provided at the school.

Event Sites

- Volleyball/Basketball/Wrestling contests are played at Perry Community High School or the adjacent Perry Community Middle School.
- Football/Soccer/Track contests are hosted at Dewey Field/Jim Kaufman Track. (18th Street between Lucinda and McKinley Avenue) Subvarsity soccer may also be held at the Perry Athletic Complex. (McKinley Avenue north of the High School)
- Baseball/Softball contests are played at the Perry Athletic Complex. (McKinley Avenue north of the High School)
- The PHS Jayette Softball Tournament is hosted at Paul Graves Diamond in Pattee Park. (West 5th Street)
- Swim contests are held at the McCreary Recreation Center. (8th & McKinley)
- Cross Country/Golf contests are held at the Perry Golf & Country Club. (Highway 144 & Country Club Lane)

Nevada – 1035 15th St., Nevada.

Take Hwy 30 east to Nevada. Take 19th St. exit (exit 158) north to H Avenue. Turn left, the softball field, track, and football/soccer field is on the right. Nevada High School is directly west of the football field. Baseball is played at Billy Sunday Baseball Field on the west side of town. As you approach Nevada on the west, turn left (north) on S14. Follow S14 to Billy Sunday Field. Boy's golf is played at Prairie View Golf Course, 22740 590th Ave., just off Lincoln Hwy (old Hwy 30) between Ames and Nevada. Girl's golf is played on Country Club Road. Take 19th St. exit (exit 158) off of Hwy 30. Go straight at stop sign to the T intersection at 11th St. Turn left (south) and go 2 miles and you will run into the driveway.

Travel time 1 hour 20 minutes.

Nodaway Valley - 410 NW Second Street, Greenfield.

Take Hwy 30 east to Scranton. Turn right (south) on Hwy 25 through Bayard, Guthrie Center, all the way to Greenfield. The school is located on the north edge of town just off to the right on N. Townline Rd, then left on NW 2nd St.

Travel time 1 hour 10 minutes.

Norwalk - 1201 North Avenue, Norwalk.

Take Hwy 30 to Ogden, turn right on Hwy 169 and go south to Hwy 41, turn left on Hwy 141 and go to I 35. Merge onto 1-35 S for 81/2 miles, then merge onto IA5 S (exit 68) towards the Des Moines Airport (5 miles). Take the IA28 exit (exit 99) toward Norwalk (turn right), then turn left on North Avenue and go just past Cherry Parkway. The school is on the left.

Travel time 2 hours.

North Polk (Alleman) – 13930 NE 6th St.

Take Hwy 30 east through Ames. Turn right onto Hwy 69 (Duff Ave exit, exit 148) and go south 13 miles. Turn right onto NE 142nd Ave. In 1/2 mile, turn left onto NE 6th St. the school is on the right.

Travel time 1 hour 32 minutes.

Fort Dodge High School– 819 N. 25th Street, Ft. Dodge.

Fort Dodge St. Edmond – 2220 4th Ave. N

Come into Fort Dodge from the south and west on Hwy 20. Stay on Hwy 20 (also Fifth Avenue S.) until 15th Street. Turn north (left) and go to 6th Avenue North. Turn right and go to 22nd Street. Go straight on 22nd St and you will see St. Edmonds High School on the right side. Two blocks later you will see Fort Dodge Senior High on the left. The State Softball Tournament is held at Harlan Rogers Field. From Hwy 20 turn left on Hwy 169 and continue 3 miles north of the Starlite Motel. Turn right (east) go on D14 for 2 miles. Turn left (north) onto P59. Go 1 mile north. Harlan Rogers Field will be on the right

Travel time for both schools is 1 hour 15 minutes.

Glenwood – 400 Sivers Rd, Glenwood.

Take Hwy 71 south to I-80. Take I-80 west and south to Council Bluffs. Take I-29 south to Hwy 34; go east on Hwy 34 to Glenwood. Turn left onto Coast St., continue into town, turn right on Sharp St (4 way stop) and go 5 blocks or so, turn left on Sivers Rd.

Travel time 2 hours 15 minutes

Gowrie (Southeast Valley) – 1005 Riddle St, Gowrie.

Take Hwy 71 north to Auburn. Turn right and go east on Hwy 175 to Gowrie. For Volleyball – take the first left (north) into town and then the first right and go 4 blocks. You will be on the south side of the high school. For track - take the second left into Gowrie (golf course), go 1/2 mile north and continue to stop sign. Turn west on Main St and right on Beek St. to the football and track complex.

Travel time is 50 min

Greene County – 101 Ram Drive, Jefferson.

Take Hwy 30 east to Jefferson. Turn right (south) on Hwy 4. Hwy 4 turns into N. Elm St. Go to the south end of town to 101 Ram Drive, to the high school for football, track, and baseball. For basketball, wrestling and volleyball go to the Middle School at 203 W. Harrison St., located on Hwy 4 just south of the Rec Center. For softball, come to the middle of Jefferson at the stop sign on Hwy 4. Turn left (east) on Lincoln Way and go around 9 blocks. Golf is held at Raccoon Bend Golf Course on the south end of Jefferson on the west side of Hwy 4.

Travel time is 40 minutes.

Harlan – 2102 Durant St., Harlan.

Enter Harlan from the north on Hwy 59; turn left (east) at the business district sign on Cyclone Ave. Take the first right which will take you into the schools' north parking lot.

For softball and baseball – continue east on Cyclone Avenue to the east side of Harlan. Football, Track and Soccer are played at Merrill Field. Continue on Hwy 59 south past the high school to the four-way stop. Turn left and go east to the 2nd stoplight (12th St) and turn left. Then take the first right and you will see the field.

Travel time is 1 hour.

Humboldt – 1500 Wildcat Road, Humboldt.

From Ft Dodge take Hwy 169 north. The school is located on the southern part of town. Please park in the parking lot west of the school. (Football) The football field is located right to the west of the high school. From the stop light on Hwy 169, at the high school just turn west and the football field is right past the parking lot on the west side of the school.

Travel time 1 hour 30 minutes.

KM-Manning – 209 Tenth Street, Manning.

Take Hwy 71 south to Hwy 141. Turn right (west) on Hwy 141 to Manning. At the east edge of Manning, turn left and drive around the south side of the school and park in the west parking area. *Travel time 25 minutes.* 9/JV Basketball is played at Manning, Golf is played at the Manning Manilla Golf & Country Club, west out of Manning on Hwy 141. Softball is played at Irwin. Take M47 south out of Manilla, nine miles to Irwin.

Travel time 45 min.

Iowa Central Community College – 330 Ave. M., Ft Dodge.

Take Hwy 71 north to Auburn, turn right onto IA-175 and go 1 mile then turn left onto N26 (Dakota Ave). When you are north of Lytton turn right onto Hwy 20 for 28.8 miles. Turn left at exit for D36. Turn right onto D20. At first set of stoplights continue on Kenyon Road for .5 miles and turn left at the next stoplight (Triton Drive) and go north onto the ICCC campus. Turn right at the direction sign and drive to the new parking ramp, you will see a large parking lot between the gym on the west and the dorms/classrooms on the east.

Travel time is 1 hour.

Johnston – Summit 6/7 School, 9500 Windsor Parkway.

Just south of Grimes on Hwy 141, take 62nd St. east. At the first stop sign take a right and go south on 100th St, then left on Windsor Parkway. *Travel time 1 hour 30 minutes.*

Kuemper – 109 S. Clark, Football, track, and baseball played at the Carroll Stadium. Soccer is played at the Kuemper Fieldhouse field. Volleyball, wrestling, and basketball played at Kuemper High School. Golf is played at the Country Club, Muni, and Breda course.

LeMars – 921 Third Ave SW

Take hwy 75 north at first exit turn when you reach Hy-Vee (about 1/2 mile) Turn right and stay on that road, the football field is about 1/2 mile.

Lewis Central – 3525 Hwy 275, Council Bluffs.

On Interstate 29, take exit 47. Turn right off the exit and proceed down the hill to the stoplight. Turn right at the stoplight. You will be on Hwy 275, turn right at the first stoplight. The football field is located between the high school and the middle school. (Swim) is located at Titan Hill Intermediate School, 2000 Hwy 275, on Interstate 29, take exit 47. Turn right off the exit and proceed down the hill to the stoplight. Turn right at the stoplight. You will be on Hwy 275, turn left at the third stoplight.

Travel time 2 hours.

Manson - 1601 15th Street, Manson.

Take Hwy 71 north to Auburn, turn right (east) on Hwy 175 to Lohrville. Turn left (north) on N65 to Manson. Continue north through Manson on N65. The track/football field will be on the right before you leave town. *Travel time 1 hour.*

Marshalltown HS Community “Y” – 108 Washington St.

For Swimming: Take Hwy 30 east to Marshalltown. Turn left at US-30 E Take exit 185 for IA-14 toward Business District/Marshalltown Turn left at IA-14 N/S Center St. Turn right at E Olive St.

1602 2nd Ave, Marshalltown.

Travel time 2 hours.

Mid American Center – 1 Arena Way, Lewis Iowa.

Take Hwy 71 south to I-80, Take I-80 west for 58.62 miles and take the 24th st exit (Exit 1A), turn right on S 24th st, then left on 27th Ave. 27th Ave becomes Mid American Drive, turn right onto Marc Blvd, then left onto Arena Way. Mid American Center is on the right.

Travel time 1 hour 51 minutes.
